BASKETBALL

- Each game will be to 20 points.
- Teams score by regular two-point baskets
- After a basket has been scored or a foul called, a player must put the ball in play from above the foul key.
- All held balls will be put into play with possession given alternately to each team.
- On defensive rebounds or steals, players must return the ball by dribble or pass across the three point line before a basket may be attempted. Once across the line, they do not have to pass the ball before shooting.
- Any player may convert an offensive rebound.
- After a basket, the team that scored will put the ball in play. Make it, take it!
- Fouls will be called by participating players. A foul called in the act of shooting will result in two points being awarded to the team which was fouled. A non-shooting foul will result in the ball taken out of bounds.
- The three second free throw lane rule will apply to all offensive players.
- Substitutions may be made after a basket or an out of bounds play.
- There are no time outs.
- Time will not be stopped to discuss any call.
